That gap is not a statistic. It is a mother who cannot afford morphine. A father dying alone in a ward, far from home. A child who watches a parent suffer when they don't have to.

What Your Support Made Possible in 2025

Our total income for the year was KSh. 33,985,192 which enabled us to accomplish the following:

208 new patients	377 morphine doses given
686 follow-up visits	328 community members reached

- **674** Thanksgiving Thursday attendances — patients who come to us for comfort and community
- 328 people reached through community outreach, bringing hospice care to those who didn't know it existed
- ~KSh. 3.5M in in-kind support through our Grand Nairobi Bike Race partnerships
- Social media reach grew by **250%**, bringing new donors, volunteers and corporate partners to our mission
